- 1:45p, Chris initiated meeting.

- Lillian Thomas article in Pgh. Post Gazette today: "Beggars Need a Change, Not Coins". Members noted that the article itself was fairly benign. One concern noted with regard to the pictures utilized in this article as it portrays a "homeless" panhandler and children walking by with adult appearing to be preventing the child from some form of danger. The picture conveys a message of fear. An issue noted to NOT be raised in the article is the homelessness does not equal panhandling. General discussion regarding. A Brief discussion related to potential of letter to the editor of the paper in response to the article. Average individuals do not and would not realize that Street Behavior VS Homelessness are very different things. Adrienne raises the issue that we (general homeless providers) cannot react vehemently, instead react with empathy and offer education! Again, the article is fairly benign, but a picture speaks many words: gives a perception of fear/fearful/threatening. Some further points discussed: Journalists have

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increased responsibility to provide the general public with appropriate/accurate info. CHSC receives calls all of the time regarding persons with whom individuals are concerned about/fearful about/irritated with and the central issue is homeless/panhandling. It was also discussed that monies being given to the Ministerium is a good thing, panhandlers might "go away", but the homeless issue remains. It is just more *out of sight, out of mind*. There still needs to be PUBLIC EDUCATION. Homelessness remains on the rise! It was determined that a letter to the editor is indicated. Chris, Diane and Becky will work on this and submit to HOCC members for review/changes before sending. This will be done via email, as it is the fastest. Those who are on the HOCC email list will receive, please review and give feedback.

- Mac raises the issue that the BOATHOUSE is gone; there is now a bike path in its place. After consistent follow-up, Mac did discover that all articles that were at the boathouse were thrown away "due to health issues". The articles were not kept for the time specification outlined in the court order. This is in contempt of the current court order and the ACLU is aware. This raises the issue of sweeps: With the last round of sweeps in April, 2005, it remains that articles taken in a sweep may be picked up for the first three days following a sweep, but it does not mention where the articles are after the three day period. There have been limited sweeps this spring. Vic Walzak is aware, probable return to court in 6/05 sometime to address the contempt issue and to address the storage issue of the articles taken in the sweeps. The Three Rivers Arts Festival is coming up, this usually means a sweep will be scheduled.
- Review for Allegheny C. Homeless Alliance-Quarterly Committee Report. Terri Laver is with need for committee report from HOCC. Details include: Committee name, focus of committee, current goals, goals achieved this quarter, list of Chair/Co-Chair persons and contact information, future goals, who regularly attends the committee meetings, meeting date/time/location. Review of this information. Chris and Becky will finalize and get this to Terri Laver.
- Northside issues: New council member is in place. There has been some communication with the new council member reported.
- The Living Room-This Sunday drop-in has been forced to close due to funding/staffing issues. Additionally, the building in which it was housed is to be sold. There was neither community nor any financial support to keep this active engagement center open. Report that the Living Room was on its way to working on employment options, small business, etc. the average attendance on Sunday's was approximately 100 folks.
- Article distributed: "Addiction Woes Haunt the Homeless". This is the type of article to use as tool/info as back-up info/data/stats for future use.
- General discussion regarding costs associated with housing a person in jail/hospital/shelter. The jail base rate for a cell is \$65. Hospital is not known, as this varies dependent on hospital and what care setting the person is in. Shelter cost is approximately \$15/night, including all overhead costs. Housing First models-already there are stats in place showing that this is a very cost efficient and effective model.
- JUNE 10th, 2005: Diane McMahon has scheduled a trip to Columbus to view MaryHaven, the engagement center in Columbus. Report that the set-up is very drug and alcohol in its base. It is set up much like a hospital. Chris, Mac, Diane McMahon, Harvey and possibly Mike Lindsey are planning to attend. The center there is funded partially by and attorney/fundraising efforts. There is also an association with a very large addictions program in the area. ⑤ KUDOS!! THANK YOU DIANE MCMAHON FOR ORGANIZING THE OHIO TRIP!! ⑥
